About the Rockets

The ROCKETS home ground is at Eric Mobbs Reserve, Fields 3&4, Ferguson Ave, Castle Hill.

The Club caters for all ages, male and female, and provides the opportunity for people to play or learn the game in a competitive or social atmosphere. From 5 years to whatever age, the ROCKETS can provide something for everyone through programs such as:

- Funskills - non competitive, intra club, for girls & boys aged 5-6.
- In-House - non competitive, intra club, for girls & boys aged 7-8
- Junior Soccer competition for girls and boys aged 9-17.
- Female Soccer competition for girls and ladies 10 – All Age.
- Senior Soccer competition for ladies and men of all ages.



All registered players are supplied with socks free of charge. Shorts are available for purchase from the Canteen. Shirts are issued to team managers and must be returned in good condition at the end of the season.

Canteen & Ground Duty

All teams are required to participate in canteen and ground duty for approximately 2 half days during the playing season. This involves parents and guardians - your attendance on these occasions will be expected and the support given is very much appreciated.

Grading Policy

Our grading policy is designed so that players have the opportunity to play in a competitive environment, appropriate to their skill and ability, and players, coaches and parents alike, have FUN, enjoy the season, and return to the club year after year. Grading does NOT apply to our Funskills or In-House programmes.

Grading for – Funskills <> In-House Ages 5-8

In 2010 the Rockets will be adopting the Football Federation Australia (FFA) Small-Sided Games guidelines for the conducting of our Funskills & In-House matches. Grading does not apply to ages 5-8.

Grading for Ages 9 To 18 – Junior

The grading policy recognises the benefits of building upon the teamwork established throughout the season and previous years. A cornerstone of the grading policy is to allow the core or nucleus of a team to be retained, year after year. Players returning from the previous season and players who are new to the club are all taken through the same comprehensive grading process, conducted by the grading committee. For returning players, performance in the previous season is also considered.

Code of Conduct
